## Guideline Subject: Third Party Procurement or Disposal Providers

- 1. Under Section 40 (1) of the PPDA Act, 2003 the Authority shall issue Guidelines on third party procurement and disposal.
- Where there is lack of technical capacity, a PDE may with the approval of the Authority procure third party procurement and disposal services on case by case basis.
- 3. Under Section 40 (2) (b) of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2003, the Authority shall pre-qualify firms to provide procurement and disposal line support services to Procuring and Disposing Entities on issues where there is lack of technical capacity.
- 4. A procuring and disposing entity shall competitively obtain those services from among firms pre-qualified by the Authority. The list of pre-qualified firms can be obtained from the Authority's website at <a href="https://www.ppda.go.ug">www.ppda.go.ug</a>
